Cedar Crest College is committed to ensuring students with disabilities are not discriminated against because of their disability and that equal access is provided to all students.

Disability Services provides reasonable accommodations, to otherwise qualified students with disabilities, to ensure access to our living and learning environments, both in person and online.

College students with disabilities who wish to request accommodations need to “self-identify” to the Asst. Director of Learning and Disability Services. To disclose information about your disability and request accommodations, you will:

Complete a student “Self-Disclosure” meeting with Sue Barnes, Asst. Director of Learning and Disability Services. During this meeting you will discuss your condition and how it affects you with regard to learning or living in campus housing.
