Electives must be included to ensure that the overall total number of credits reaches the minimum of 120 credits needed to complete a degree.

PLEASE NOTE:

***In the course of completing all of the above requirements for the major, students are required to choose 5 take 200-level ENG courses at the 300-level (see the Catalog for a listing of courses that are also offered at the 300-level; ENG 200 may not be taken at the 300-level). The core major requirement to take at least 2 300-level literature electives counts toward the 5. Students taking a 200-level ENG course at the 300-level will be expected to complete alternate assignments for the course that reflect engagement with the course materials at a more

advanced level. English majors will discuss with their major advisor at the time of registration for classes each semester whether they wish to roster any ENG courses at the 300-level and which course(s). Their advisor will then contact the Registrar to register the student individually for the 300-level course number that corresponds to each chosen 200-level course.
