Students must fulfill all LAC requirements (unless stated otherwise) and Nursing Prerequisites to be fully accepted into the Nursing major.

To begin junior level courses, the student must have earned at least a grade of B- (B minus) in four of the five prerequisite science courses: CHE 103, BIO 117, BIO 118, BIO 127 and NTR 210.

A grade of C or C+ is permitted in only one prerequisite science course. In the remaining prerequisite courses, a grade of C or better is required while still meeting the 2.7 prerequisite GPA.

*The first semester MAT class will be based upon ALEKS score. MAT 110 is recommended to be taken before CHE 103.
