Only declared students are permitted to register for 300-level education courses.
- EDU 374 Professional Seminar must be taken with 373 (student teaching). Students may not be enrolled in any other course(s) during the student teaching semester.
- A minimum of 120 credits is required for graduation.
- Students who are not proficient in oral/written communication in the English language may be required to take additional courses to meet basic competencies in English communication.
- Please see your advisor if transfer coursework is over 5 years old.
