

## Faculty-led Study Tours Financial Planning

Faculty-led study tours generally have a course component and a tour component. The course component is billed by the College the same way as other classes for each student. For full-time traditional students, it is part of the comprehensive tuition (12 to 19 credits). For part-time traditional students and SAGE students, the class is charged per credit. The tour component is billed to cover the actual tour (airfare, passports and/or visas, housing, etc.) Students are encouraged to visit the Student Financial Services office located in Blaney Hall Room 212 to find out what options may be available to cover the tour component. These options vary for each student depending on their current financial aid as the actual tour on its own does not qualify for financial aid (state and/or federal grants and/or loans).
