- ✓ Submit ID Card Photograph by emailing <u>lisa.wallitsch@cedarcrest.edu</u>
 - Email a photo of yourself with no additional people in the photo, on a neutral background, no hats or sunglasses. Be sure to include "incoming student fall 2021" in your email. The photo provided will go through an approval process and if the photo is approved you will receive an email confirmation. ID cards will be provided during Orientation Check-in on August 19, 2021.
