- April 15, 2024 for students starting in Summer 2024

- ✓ Register for Orientation
 - Plan to arrive on campus to participate in the International Student Orientation Program prior to the start of classes. More details will be sent to your email by International Student Services.

- ✓ Health Forms (due January 2 or within one week of enrolling): Access Medicat through FalconLink and follow the prompts.

- ✓ **Review and Complete the FERPA Form** (No Deadline)
- ✓ If you are a student with a disability who may need academic or other accommodations at Cedar Crest, please request information by sending an email to Academic Services (<u>advising@cedarcrest.edu</u>) and writing Disability Resources in the subject line. You can also schedule an appointment <u>here.</u>
- ✓ Submit ID Card Photograph by emailing <u>conferenceservices@cedarcrest.edu</u> Email a photo of yourself with no additional people in the photo, on a neutral background, no hats, or sunglasses. Be sure to include "incoming student spring 2024" in your email. The photo provided will go through an approval process and if approved you will receive email confirmation. ID cards are distributed during Spring Welcome Night or International Student Orientation.
- ✓ Parking Permit Registration To register, students will need to show their vehicle registration, proof of insurance, current driver's license, and Cedar Crest College photo ID to obtain their decals (available at Campus Police 24/7)
- ✓ Sign-up for Commuter Meal Plan -Commuters only
