

Before your advising appointment

- Take the <u>ALEKS Math Assessment</u>. The ALEKS assessment should take you about 60 minutes and will allow you to be placed into the most appropriate math class. When prompted for the class code, please enter <u>DDGUC-</u> <u>JWHKK</u>

- Parking Permit Registration To register, students will need to show their vehicle registration, proof of insurance, current driver's license, and Cedar Crest College ID number to obtain their decals (available at Campus Police 24/7)

- Health Insurance Waiver If you have insurance through Medical Assistance in any state other than Pennsylvania, this insurance will not be accepted in PA. You will then need to purchase the CCC Student Insurance Plan.
- Submit ID Card Photograph by emailing <u>conferenceservices@cedarcrest.edu</u> Email a photo of yourself (no additional people in the photo, neutral background, no hats, or sunglasses). Include "incoming student Fall 2024" in your email. The photo provided requires approval. If approved, you will receive an email confirmation. ID cards will be provided during Orientation or can be picked up during the first week of the semester.

Additional steps before the start of the semester

- Make sure to regularly check your tuition bill and keep in contact with Student Financial Services to ensure all financial aid is applied to your account and your payments for your tuition are up to date.
