Notetaking Tips

- Try different styles (Cornell, mind maps, etc.)
- Match your method to your learning style
- Skim first, then read in-depth
- Focus on key ideas—don't write everything

- Use color, symbols, and formatting
- Note questions as you read
- Use your own words
- Create acronyms or shortcuts
- Pretend you're explaining to a friend
- Summarize at the end

Study Tips

- Use AI or flashcards for practice questions
- Draw/label diagrams
- Make your own practice problems
- Try different methods per subject
- Study with a buddy

- Learn key terms and vocab
- Teach others (or fake it)
- Avoid studying in bed
- Ask Al to simplify tough topics
- Record and listen to topic summaries
