

SUMMER HOUSING INFORMATION 2022

SUMMER HOUSING IS LIMITED

Summer housing is a convenient, affordable option for students taking classes or working. Students who are enrolled in summer courses, involved in full-time research on campus, completing an internship or employed as a summer student worker or in verified off-campus employment may request to stay on campus for the summer. Summer residents will be housed in Curtis Hall. If overflow housing is necessary, Summer residents will be housed in another residence hall on campus. RAs will be available on the floor to answer questions and provide support.

REQUEST FORM

If you plan to live on campus this summer, please complete the Summer Housing Request form, available on the Student Affairs tab in the Residence Life folder on MyCedarCrest. Students will be placed in summer housing on a first come, first served basis.

HOUSING RATES

The weekly housing rates are as follows:

Double*: \$130

Medical Single: \$130

Single: \$140

*Traditional students who are conducting research approved by an academic department; completing a minimum 120 hour summer internship; or taking six or more credits per summer session qualify for a free double room. If a student resides in a single, then the student is responsible for paying the \$10/week difference.

IMPORTANT DATES

Summer Session I Move-Over Date: Monday, May 16 at 12 noon

You may remain in your current room until this time, but you must be present and move on this date. You must be out of your spring room by 10 p.m.

Summer Session I Move-Out Date: Monday, June 29 by 12 noon

Summer Session II Move-In Date: Tuesday, July 6 at 12 noon

If you will only be in summer housing during Summer Session II then you must remove your belongings from your current spring room.

Summer Session II Move-Over Date: Wednesday, August 19 at 12 noon

You must be present to move out of your summer room and into your fall room on this date. You must be out of your summer room by 10 p.m.

Dining

There will be no on campus dining options. Students can take advantage of area grocery stores and restaurants.
