

SUMMER HOUSING INFORMATION 2020

SUMMER HOUSING IS LIMITED

Summer housing is a convenient, affordable option for students taking classes or working. Students who are enrolled in summer courses, involved in full-time research on campus, completing an internship or employed as a summer student worker or in verified off-campus employment may request to stay on campus for the summer. Summer residents will be housed in Curtis Hall. RAs will be available on the floor to answer questions and provide support.

REQUEST FORM

If you plan to live on campus this summer, please complete the Summer Housing Request form, available on the Student Affairs tab in the Residence Life folder on MyCedarCrest. Students will be placed in summer housing on a first come, first served basis.

HOUSING RATES

The weekly housing rates are as follows:

Double*: \$120

Medical Single: \$120

Single: \$130

*Traditional students who are conducting research approved by an academic department; completing a minimum 120 hour summer internship; or taking six or more credits per summer session qualify for a free double room. If a student resides in a single, then the student is responsible for paying the \$10/week difference.

IMPORTANT DATES

Summer Session I Move-Over Date: Monday, May 11 at 12 noon

You may remain in your current room until this time, but you must be present and move on this date. You must be out of your spring room by 10 p.m.

Summer Session I Move-Out Date: Thursday, June 25 by 12 noon

Summer Session II Move-In Date: Monday, June 29 at 12 noon

If you will only be in summer housing during Summer Session II then you must remove your belongings from your current spring room.

Summer Session II Move-Over Date: Wednesday, August 12 at 12 noon

You must be present to move out of your summer room and in to your fall room on this date. You must be out of your summer room by 10 p.m. You may be asked to move to a temporary

room or your fall room, if your summer room is needed for a student arriving early for the fall semester.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Dining

During the summer, the Falcon's Nest will be open from 8:15 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. No summer meal plan is available. However, you can deposit money on your card (called voluntary flex) and use it like a debit card in the Falcon's Nest so that you don't have to carry around cash. Food Services staff can answer any further questions.

Health Services

The Health Services office is not open during the summer. In the event that you need medical care, please contact your family physician. In the event that you need to access counseling services, you are encouraged to use your regular provider.
